# KOMEN ATLANTA COMMUNITY PROFILE 2010




Susan G. Komen for the Cure Greater Atlanta Affiliate is the local resource for breast cancer screening, treatment, education and support. Through events, including the Race for the Cure, and contributions, the Affiliate raises funds to enable women to detect and survive breast cancer. The organization conducts a biennial Community Needs Assessment to discover the status of breast health, breast cancer and related services within the Affiliate's 10-county service area. Komen Atlanta's extensive grants program addresses those unmet needs and disparities by funding breast health programs in the community for the medically underserved.


### **GWINNETT COUNTY**



### In the Komen Atlanta Service Area:


- Gwinnett County has the 2nd largest population within the Komen Atlanta service area.
- Gwinnett currently has the 3rd lowest incidence of breast cancer among females in the service area
- Gwinnett ranks 5th in the service area for percentage of late stage diagnosis, tied with Cobb County.
- Gwinnett has the lowest mortality rate within the service area.
- Gwinnett ranks 6th in the service area in terms of women 40 and older not receiving mammograms
- Gwinnett has the 2nd smallest number of uninsured women.
- Gwinnett has the 4th highest percentage of families living below the poverty level.




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### 2009 Gwinnett Mortality Rate by Race, per 100k



### 2009 Gwinnett Incidence Rate by Age Group, per 100k


